

DISASTER DECLARATION FOR MARION COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the County of Marion, Texas on this 7th day of July 2024, is under immediate threat of widespread and severe damage, injury, or loss of life resulting in the impending arrival of Hurricane BERYL which is expected to make land fall on the Texas Coast, affecting the waterways in and around Marion County.

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Marion has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of the people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

THEREFORE, Be It Proclaimed by The County Judge of Marion County that:

- 1. A local state of disaster is hereby declared for Marion County, pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. The state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Marion County Commissioners Court, pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code.
- 3. This declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Marion County Clerk, pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code.
- 4. This declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Marion County Emergency Plan, pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code.
- 5. This Declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
